About the course/workshop	Learn the art of drawing and sculpting with wire to create your very own sunflower. Starting with a template you will be shown how to trace an outline and then shape, join and weave to make it 3D, using a variety of coloured copper wires and copper mesh. There will be step by step instructions as you go along as well as an introduction to pliers and their different uses. You'll need good dexterity for this fine work but its a lot of fun making this happy flower!
