Exam Results

Now that all the results and re-marks from the summer have been reviewed and verified, I am thrilled to share with you another year of excellent results at Maiden Erlegh.

A Level Headlines:

- 34.5% of students achieved an A* or A (or equivalent) in all exams
- 62% of students achieved an A* to B (or equivalent) in all exams
- 84.2% of students achieved an A* to C (or equivalent) in all exams
- The average grade achieved in all exams was a B

GCSE Headlines:

- Progress 8 figure (based on CAT tests) = 0.9
- Attainment 8 figure = 55.95
- 77.3% of students achieved a grade 9-4 in both English and Maths
- 80.9% of students achieved at least 5 grade 4-9 in their GCSEs
- 70.8% of students achieved at least 5 grade 5-9 in their GCSEs



Please note that the last day of this half term will be Tuesday 21 October, and students will finish at 3pm. School will reopen on Monday 3 November at 8.30am for the start of the second half of the autumn term.
