



Paracetamol Administration Consent – Secondary School

We would like your consent to administer the occasional dose of non-prescription paracetamol to your child during the school day and on school trips or off-site activities, should they experience a headache or other mild to moderate pain. Age-appropriate dosage guidelines will always be followed.

We will not administer Paracetamol to a child unless we have recorded permission in our system, as outlined below.

We will always inform you when paracetamol has been administered, including the dosage and reason(s).

If your child needs paracetamol within four hours of arriving at school, we will contact you to confirm whether they have already taken any that morning to ensure a minimum 4-hour gap between doses.

If your child has any medical conditions that require detailed or ongoing management, please inform the school office directly with full information.

Providing consent on MyChildAtSchool (MCAS) App

1. Log in to MCAS
2. Go to **View Student Details** → **Other Details** and select the Paracetamol Administration Consent
3. Select **Submit Changes**

If you do not give consent on MCAS, we will assume that you do not give permission for paracetamol to be administered in school.
