Dear Parent/Guardian

Admissions Information Required

Preparations are underway to ensure a smooth transition for your child into Year 7 in September 2026. We are working with your child's primary school to gather the information needed to support them.

As we prepare to welcome our new Year 7 cohort, we ask all Year 6 parents and carers to complete the admissions forms. This information is essential for finalising your child's admission and ensuring a successful start to school.

You will be asked to provide key details such as contact information, medical needs, emergency contacts, and supply consent for activities and school-related services. We ask that all parents provide their national insurance number and date of birth for free school meals (FSM) eligibility checks. Even if you do not wish to use this funding, the school can use this information to access additional funding that directly supports your child's education. MyChildAtSchool (MCAS) App

We will be using the MyChildAtSchool (MCAS) app, which allows you to securely submit your child's information directly into our Bromcom Management Information System (MIS). In addition to the mobile app, MCAS can also be accessed on a desktop computer by visiting www.MyChildAtSchool.com.

Tomorrow, you will receive a **personalised login email** from Maiden Erlegh School (12716@bromcomcloud.com). **Once received, please activate your account within 24 hours.** If your 24-hour reset link has expired, enter your email address again and select **Reset Password**. A new email will be sent to you with a fresh link to reset your password. We kindly request that all admissions information is completed by **Friday 19 June**.



If you already have an MCAS account for another child, you can access information for all your children through a single MCAS account. As long as your email address is identical and registered with the school for all your children, you can view and manage their details in one place.

How to Switch Between Children

- **In the MCAS App:** On the **My Child** dashboard, tap the **student's name** next to their photograph to open a drop-down list, then select the other child you wish to view.
- **On the MCAS Website:** Click on the **child's name in the top left-hand corner** of your dashboard to switch between linked children.

Please note that the admissions information can only be submitted once; however, further changes can be made after submission through the Data Collection section in the MCAS app. If you already have a sibling at the school, some of your information may already appear — please check this thoroughly. Any changes made to your contact details will be updated across all siblings.
