Dear Parent/Guardian

Year 10 students have put in a huge effort to prepare for their RP exam, and we hope that they are feeling proud of themselves for completing plenty of revision and experiencing their first real exams. We would now like them to focus their attention on their core subject: **English**. As you may be aware, students must achieve a **grade 4** in English language to avoid resitting next year and many sixth forms and colleges require a **grade 5** or above to access their courses. We would like to help to prepare them for this by sitting their second PPE for English on **Wednesday 17 June 2026**.

They will be completing (Pearson Edexcel) Language Paper 1 which we have been preparing for in lessons. The paper consists of a reading section where students will read and answer questions about an unseen 19th century extract and an imaginative writing section where students will write a story based on a choice of prompt. Students have been told about this in class and have received further guidance in an assembly.

The paper is worth 64 marks, which provides **40%** of their total mark for language.

Revision resources and past papers, with guidance slides, are posted on a Google Classroom page that students have been invited to join.
