Year 12 and Year 13 - 16 to 19 Bursary Fund 2026/2027 – New Applications

The 16 to 19 Bursary fund is a scheme made available from the government through its funding body – the Education Funding Agency (EFA) for 16-19-year-olds - to provide assistance to students whose access to, or completion of, education is inhibited by financial constraints or barriers. Applications are now open for all students who would like to apply for this funding. This discretionary bursary is available to those students who would otherwise find it difficult to continue with their education and is to be used primarily to pay for the following:

- **Field Trips** – any field trip that relates to a course being taken.
- **Uniform** – purchases must conform to the school uniform policy for Sixth Form.
- **Educational IT Equipment and software** e.g. laptop or tablet.
- **Transport** – this covers the cost of either a weekly or monthly season ticket.
- **Stationery**
- **Books**
- **University visits and interviews** – a maximum of two open day visits can be made during term time.
- **School meals**

To be eligible to receive a Bursary, young people must be 16, 17 or 18 on 31 August 2026 and be studying in the school sixth form and meet the EFA residency qualifications as set out via the following link <https://www.gov.uk/1619-bursary-fund/overview> on the Department for Education website.

This is a limited fund and the school will prioritise allocations, however there will be two priority groups, categorised as high (A) and low (B) dependent on household income:

High Priority Group (A) - This is for young people aged at least 16 and less than 19 years of age on 31 August 2026 with a gross annual household income of below £20,000.

Low priority group (B) - This is for young people aged at least 16 and less than 19 years of age on 31 August 2026 with a gross annual household income of between £20,000 and £30,000.



Forms are available on the school website [here](#) or from Mrs Sandhu in 6th Form Supervised Study. The deadline to return this form is 3pm Friday 25 September 2026. No late applications will be accepted. Please note that financial evidence will need to be submitted alongside the application form and without this, the application will be invalid.

Please note that if the students was awarded a Bursary in the previous academic year, this will not be automatically renewed and a new application will need to be made for each student applying with new financial evidence for the current year. Details are provided within the application pack.
