Dear Parent/Guardian

Year 7 - Trip to Chessington World of Adventures – Thursday 8 October 2026 (M's) and Thursday 15 October 2026 (E's)

In order to support our Foundation students in settling into Maiden Erleigh School and promoting a successful start to the academic year, we have organised a trip for the entire year group to visit Chessington World of Adventures.

The trip will be taking place on Thursday 8 October 2026 for students on the M side of the year and Thursday 15 October 2026 for students on the E side of the year. **Please be aware that if your child is in the M5 tutor group, half are taught on the M side of the year, and half will be taught on the E side of the year, and they will go on the trip with their respective year half.** Students will be expected to arrive at Maiden Erleigh School and meet under the covered walkway for 8.30am for prompt departure at 9am. We should arrive back at school for 5pm. If this return time is delayed, we will ask the students to contact you and let you know our revised time of arrival.

As this is a recreational trip, there will be a charge of £30 and without this full contribution, the trip will be unable to go ahead. This price is based upon a full coach, if we are unable to fill a whole coach then there may be a slight price increase. This payment will cover the entrance fee and travel by coach. Unfortunately, on this occasion, we will not be able to accept Merlin passes for this trip. The trip is open to all Year 7 students.

Please note this is a non-refundable payment. If your child is unable to attend this trip due to illness, unfortunately we are unable to guarantee a refund, however we will endeavour to offer a full/partial refund if:

- Another student replaces your child's place on the trip.
- The school can agree a full/partial refund from external agencies with whom the trip is booked.

During your child's visit to Chessington, they will be checked into the facility. This is a secure facility where students will be allowed to explore independently and there will be a supervised meeting point at all times during the day should students require anything.



All students will be required to stay in groups, with a minimum of three per group at all times. Students will be required to report to a designated location at specific times during the day. If students fail to do this, they will be accompanied by a member of staff for the remainder of the visit.

Students will not be expected to wear uniform, however as ambassadors of the school they will be expected to behave in an exemplary manner. The criteria for being allowed to go are detailed below and this is in addition to our Trips & Behaviour policies:

- Attendance should be above 95% (Medical Exemptions apply)
- Punctual to registration and lessons
- All work must be completed to the best of their ability
- Behaviour must be excellent both in lessons, around school and in the community
- Uniform and other school rules must be followed

Since the students will be on this trip for the whole day, please provide your child with a packed lunch and a drink or money to buy food and drink.

A place on this trip is dependent on the student having an excellent behaviour record until the trip. This does mean no disciplinary appointments or other sanctions can be had. Please be aware, that once accepted onto the trip, monies cannot be refunded unless a replacement can be found.

If you would like your child to attend this trip, please submit payment via Parent Pay. This Payment and the trips and visits consent will be taken as permission for your child to attend. Please make this payment by **Wednesday 16 September 2026**. **Please use the following link to ParentPay <https://www.parentpay.com/>**.
